Dr. John R. Lapp, 92, passed away on Wednesday, December 16, 2020. He was the husband of Miriam L. (Harwick) Lapp. They celebrated their 67th wedding anniversary in June. Born in Allentown, he was the son of the late Charles A. and Christine E. (Faust) Lapp. He was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Allentown. He had a family practice in Trexlertown for 37 years before retiring in 1993. During his time practicing medicine he formed the Trexlertown Medical Group. He served two years for the U.S. Public Health Service and was Chief Medical Officer at Chillicothe Federal Reformatory. He worked with Dr. Albert Sabin on trials of oral polio vaccinations. He was a graduate of Muhlenberg College, Hahnemann Medical College and interned at the former Allentown Hospital.
