Carl R. Herring, 88, of Allentown passed away on October 31, 2021 at the Diakon Lutheran Home in Topton PA. He was the husband of Mary Ann (Kunkel) Herring, and they had been married for 61 years. Born in Lenhartsville PA, he was a son of the late Elton D. and Mabel (Sunday) Herring. Carl was a graduate of Kutztown High School, and then attended Penn State Center – Berks Campus and then attained his Engineering Degree at Lafayette University. He then began his career at the former Western Electric Company in Allentown, working there for many years mostly in the wire bonding department. Carl was also a U. S. Air Force Veteran, serving in the Post Korea era as Staff Sergeant navigator in a B-29 bomber. Living in Allentown most of his adult life, he was a member of the Cedar Church in Cetronia. An active member of the community, he was a longtime member of the Cetronia V.F.D. and served as the membership secretary. He was a 50 year member of the Vaux Lodge # 406 Free and Accepted Masons in Hamburg PA, Valley of Reading Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite, and also the Rajah Shrine.

Surviving in addition to his wife Mary Ann are sons Michael Herring, Steven Herring and wife Sharon of Allentown, a brother Irvin Herring of Lenhartsville PA, and grandchildren Tyler and Leah Herring. He was predeceased by a brother Donald Herring.
