Donald Dennis Bundra, 88, of Orefield, passed away Sunday, October 17, 2021 at Lehigh Valley Hospital, Salisbury Twp. He was the husband of Rose M. (Montagner) Bundra, with whom he shared nearly 68 years of marriage. Born on Christmas Day 1932 in Ormrod, he was the son of the late Joseph A. and Margaret M. (Haas) Bundra. He was a member of St. Francis of Assisi R. C. Church, Allentown. Prior to retiring, he worked for 35 years as a pipefitter/steamfitter for Steamfitters Local Union 420.
