Donald Gordon Clemons, 93, of Whitehall, passed away Sunday, December 8, 2024 at home. He was the husband of Judith A. 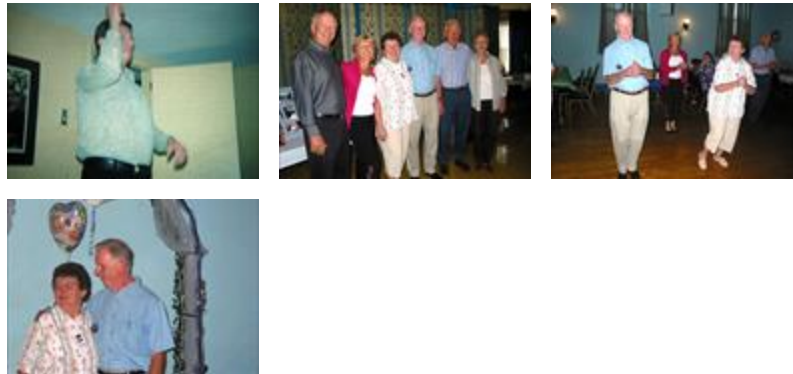
