Upon graduating from William Allen High School in 1968, he attended Lehigh University where he received a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in electrical engineering in 1972 and 1974. He worked in various capacities as an electrical engineer and IT specialist including owning his own business involved with early robotic design. Prior to his retirement in 2013, he worked in computer services at the Lehigh County Government Center for 13 years.

As Hank's professional life reflected service, so did his personal journey. He was involved in various leadership and service roles throughout the Lehigh Valley. His spirit was to serve others.
