Helen Evans Stovall, 71, of Allentown passed away Monday, January 22, 2024 in Lehigh Valley Hospice, Allentown. Born in Easton to the late George Evans Sr. and Ola Mae (Newsome) Evans.

She was an educator and Associate Director at Lehigh Valley Children's Centers Allentown for 35 years. She also started the first African American Girl Scout Group at the Negro Cultural Center on Sixth and Chew Streets, which is now known as the Allentown Health Bureau, and LVCC Judith Chase Early Learning Center.

She was Youth Leader at Union Baptist Church Allentown, and would go on to be the First Lady, Deaconess, Youth, and Choir Director of New Beginning Baptist Church Allentown founded by predeceased husband, Pastor Ralph John Stovall. She would go on to teach, inspire, motivate, support, and love all of the young people she could reach. Also often-recognized as a second mother to many young people she met. She Graduated Louis E Dieruff High School and Lehigh Carbon Community College.

She was preceded in death by her parents George Evans, and Ola Mae Newsome; Brothers Henry, Bobby, and George; Sisters Gussie, and Gertrude; husband Ralph.
